

# Writers Roundup At University

Programs for the Third Annual Writers' Roundup, to be held at Brigham Young university July 18 and 19, will be issued next week to writers of the intermountain area.

Joint sponsors of the Roundup are B. Y. U. summer session through the Journalism department; State Chapter, League of Western Writers; Salt Lake chapter of the league; and the Provo chapter. Listed on the extensive two-day program are notable journalists in fields of poetry, fiction, and feature article writing.

The programs are attractively printed, folder style, in the host university's colors of blue and white. Harrison R. Merrill, director of the extension division, Brigham Young university, is general chairman.

The Roundup will begin with registration from 8 to 11:30 a.m. Monday morning, July 18, in the hall of the Education building, and at Harley's Chateau. At 9:00 a.m. the first event of the meet, the Poets' Breakfast, will take place at the Chateau, with Mrs. Olive Woolley Burt, president of the State chapter of the writers' league, Poet Master.

## NEVADA HIGH IN PAY TO STATE LEGISLATORS

Nvada is generous in its pay to members of the state senate and assembly, according to a comparison with payments made in other western states compiled by the council of state governments.

Only California, which pays on a biennial basis of \$2400 and Colorado with \$1,000 every two years, exceed Nevada's payment of \$10 a day for a 60-day session.

Wyoming and Montana also pay \$10 a day. Other states paying a smaller amount are Arizona, \$8; Idaho, New Mexico and Washington, \$5 a day; Utah, \$4 and Oregon, \$3.

Arizona ranks high with 20 cents a mile in the matter of mileage allotted. Colorado and Oregon pay 15 cents; Nevada, Idaho, New Mexico, Utah and Washington pay 10 cents; Montana pays 7 cents; and California 5 cents.

California and Colorado set no time limit on their regular sessions; Nevada, Arizona, Idaho, New Mexico, Utah and Montana set 60 days; and Oregon and Washington set 49 days.

## Assessment Work Moratorium Act

Following we publish in full the text of Senate Bill No. 3493, which provides for the moratorium for annual assessment work on mining claims. The Act identical with the former Act except that it includes the territory of Alaska, is as follows:

### AN ACT

Providing for the Suspension of Annual Assessment work on Mining Claims Held by Location in the United States.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled: That the provision of section 2324 of the Revised Statutes of the United States, which requires on each mining claim located, and until a patent has been issued therefor, not less than \$100 worth of labor to be performed or improvements aggregating such amount to be made each year, and the same is hereby, suspended as to all mining claims in the United States during the year beginning at 12 o'clock meridian July 1, 1937, and ending at 12 o'clock meridian July 1, 1938; Provided, That the provisions of this Act shall not apply in the case of any claimant not entitled to exemption from the payment of a Federal income tax for the taxable year 1937: Provided further, That every claimant of any such mining claim, in order to obtain the benefits of this Act, shall file, or cause to be filed, in the office where the location notice or certificate is recorded, on or before 12 o'clock meridian July 1, 1938, a notice of his desire to hold said mining claim under this Act, which notice shall state that the claimant, or claimants, payment of a Federal income tax were entitled to exemption from the for the taxable year 1937; Provided further, That such suspension of assessment work shall not apply to more than six lode mining claims held by the same person, nor to more than twelve lode mining claims held by the same partnership, association, or corporation: And provided further, That such suspension of assessment work shall not apply to more than six placer-mining claims not to exceed one hundred and twenty acres (in all) held by the same person, nor to more than twelve placer-mining claims not to exceed two hundred and forty acres (in all) held by the same partnership, association, or corporation.

A wire from Senator Key iPtman states that the Act was signed by the President Wednesday, June 30.
