Copper Mines Very Prosperous

Consolidated Coppermines report to its stockholders for the third quarter, ending September 30, shows a net income of \$520,906.29, or a net balance of \$442,792.93, after deducting exploration and development charges for the period. Further deductions for amortization of mine development and depreciation bring the net income, before depletion and federal income tax, to \$330,948.13, which amount equals an earning of 20c per share on the 1,592,218 shares outstanding. This compares with 42 cents per share earned for nine months ending September 30th.

The report, which is signed by Boudinot Atterbury, states: "The drilling program has been continued and has somewhat increased proven ore reserves. Further progress has been made in regard to plans for the company's own concentrating plant and auxiliary facilities. Mr. Ira B. Joralemon, mining engineer, has been retained to report as to the economies to be expected from this program."
