



pastel tones and then bind the protector in bias tape that will repeat one of the flower tones. For blankets 72 inches wide, two yards of 36-inch material will make two protectors or one, plus trimming bands for a pair of pillow cases and a sheet. Five yards of bias tape will be needed to bind the edges of each protector. The sketch shows how material is basted in place with slip-stitching through the bindings. In this way they are easily removed for washing.


