

week period. Following last Thursday's re-moval of most meats from the ra-tioning list, the office of price administration halved the month-ly ration point allotment to 30 points a month to take up excess ration buying power.

ration buying power. Stamps U-8, V-8 and W-8 under the rationing change now will not become valid for use until June 4.

Here is the office of war infor-mation's weekly list of dates with your government:

Sugar stamps No. 30 and No. 31 valid indefinitely for five pounds of sugar. Sugar stamp No. 40 is valid for five pounds of canning sugar through February 28, 1945. Meat, fats — Red stamps A8 through T8 are now valid indefinitely. No more red stamp will be validated until June 3.

blue stamps A8 through Q8 now valid indefinitely. Fuel oil - periods 4 and 5 coupons remain valid in all areas

through August 31. Shoes - airplane stamps No. 1 and No. 2 in book three remain valid indefinitely.
