

Church Honors Mother Porter

The Hospitality Club of the Upper Room, Church of God in Christ honored Mrs. Sweetie Porter, Nevada State Superintendent of Women of the Church on Saturday, Jan. 18, at Ruben's Supper Club. The State President of the group is Mrs. Amanda Jackson and the District President is Mrs. Gertrude Moore.

Mrs. Porter, a native of Oklahoma and resident of Nevada since 1944, has served as Superintendent of Women for six years. She is directly responsible for establishing counselling for young women, mother's boards, and the Board of Missions. One of her principal activities is conducting purity classes for teenage girls.

In an interview with the Voice, Mrs. Porter stated that in addition to the great spiritual experience, she has found the opportunity of working with young people a most satisfying one. Mrs. Porter further stated that she has witnessed the continuing growth of the Church of God in Christ in Nevada. She pointed out that in 1944 the principal employment for Negroes was confined to a magnesium plant at Henderson.

Mrs. Porter is pleased with the improvements in living conditions and schools throughout the state. She feels, however, that the most pressing problem is to extend job opportunities so that the Negro can enjoy his Nevada citizenship more fully.

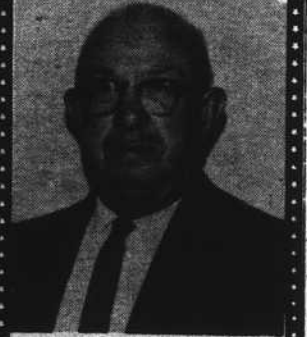

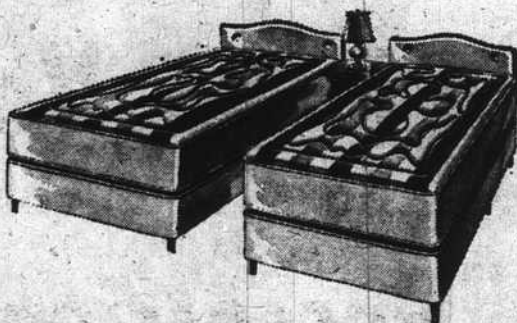

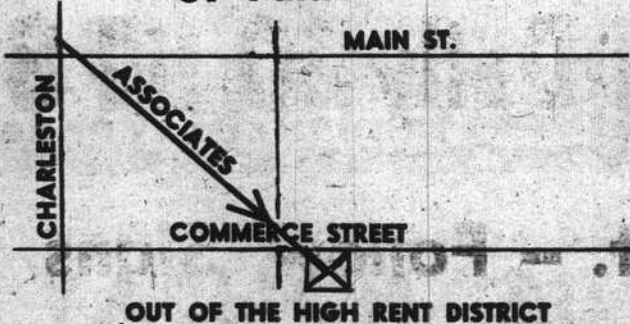
