## LAS VEGAS BOY'S CLUB

The Las Vegas Boys' Club which has been operating since November, 1963 was organized by a group of citizens who constitute the Las Vegas Boys' Club Committee. The purpose of the committee is to encourage the formation of Boys' Clubs throughout the Las Vegas area and coordinate the activities of th clubs.

Members of this committee are: C.I. West, M.D., Honorable David Zenoff, Officer Jackson, LVPD, Miss Marjorie Elliott, Bob Bailey, Robert Mullen, Probation Department, Robert Reid, Joe Haynes, Patrick O'Neil and Herb Tobman. Haynes and O'Neil of the City of Las Vegas Recreation Department are advisors to the committee. The Boys' Club activities are supervised and coodinated through a five -member executive board which is elected from and by the membership of the Las Vegas Boys' Club Committee.

To date, there are three boys' clubs established on the westside of Las Vegas, two Junior Police Clubs and an Amateur Astronomy Club. The total membership of these clubs at present is more than 50 boys between the ages of 8 and 16.

The major purposes of the boys' club is to porvide encouragement to youth; to stimulate their interest and expose them to areas of interest which they would not otherwise receive until a much later age, if at all, and to fill the void which exists in lives of most the youths in this area. the age group of the members of the Boys'Club are able to gain any type of employment either after school or weekends. The outlet and opportunities for these boys to engage in constructive activities and pursuits are very inadequate, and there is little else for them to do outside of school hours except roam thestreets with no supervision.

The committee has not yet attempted to solicit funds to support its ac-tivity. The Club has been using the facilities of the City Recreation Department and other institutions in the area. Weekly meetings of the boys' clubs are held at the Jefferson Center, "D" Street, Thursday nights between the hous of 7:30 P.M. and 9:00 P.M. Some activities in which the

combined clubs have participated have been the showing of education films, athletics and social activities.

The Committee hopes to provide awide variety of boys' club activities in order to provide some outlet for all youth who desire to associate with other boys, of appropriate age, having similar interest.

All adults who are interested in helping the youth of the community are invited to take part in the activities of the Committee.
