Area citizens have been invited for the first time to attend a meeting at the City Council Chambers concerning the City Bond Issue. As a community we should express

our disapproval of not having been including on the original committee of "100" that has revised the original bond issues. We must let City Hall know that when an issue affecting our interest is at stake, we want a part in that decision. However, the Bond Issue is of great importance to the

growth of Las Vegas. Included in its provisions are the sum for the widening of the Bonanza Underpass and \$4000,000 for Doolittle Park building. Every item on the Bond Issue is of importance. The interest of the total community should be lifted above our personal disapproval of City Hall "including us OUT of" the so called committee of "100."
