Child Killer Sentenced

One of two 16-year-old white boys convicted in the killing of a 13-year-old Negro lad last Sept. 15 has been sentenced to seven months in jail at Birmingham, Ala.

Michael Lee Farley pleaded guilty to a charge of manslaughter in

the death of James Ware, who was shot down during racial unrest that followed the bombing of a Birmingham church in which four Negro girls died.

That was Louis (Satchmo) Armstrong's reaction to reports that he had died last week following a heart attack.

"You just tell them cats who are trying to push me out the door that there's nothing wrong with the old ticker or anything else," the 63-year-old jazz trumpeter and raspy-voiced singer declared.

Armstrong underwent treatment for phlebitis--inflammation of a vein--in his left leg at Beth Israel Hospital in New York last week. A Chicago radio station allegedly started the rumor that the famous entertainer, a frequent head-liner on the Las Vegas Strip, had gone on to Green Pastures.
