

# CLERGYMEN DECRY ECONOMIC AID TO SOUTH AFRICANS

**AMERICAN BANKERS**, putting dollars above decency, are mainly responsible for maintaining the economic stability of the Inquisition-type government of the Republic of South Africa according to a prominent American church leader.

The Rev. Dr. Mackey, executive secretary of the Stewardship Council of the United Church of Christ, has just returned from a six-week tour of African missions. He said he was "shocked and dismayed" to find how much ill-feeling toward the United States existed among educated South African Negroes.

"United States money, provided by some of our largest banks, in the form of private investment capital, is supporting the South African economy to a greater extent than any other factor," the Rev. Dr. Sheldon E. Mackey said recently.

The Philadelphia theologian said Christian missionaries in South Africa are pessimistic about their future.

**EMBITTERED NEGRO** opponents of the vicious white-supremacy government of South Africa decried a "two-faced" American policy of lip-service opposition and de facto support of Prime Minister Hendrik Verwoerd's police-state.

"Due to rigid controls, there is little chance of a successful uprising against the government," the Rev. Dr. Mackey said. "The economy is boom-

ing, thanks to American investments, and South Africa could live on its resources indefinitely despite an international economic boycott."

"**ALL THEY CAN DO** is help combat poverty and illiteracy in the compounds," he said, "They know they will be sent packing if they utter one word against apartheid (strict racial separation).

The Rev. Dr. Mackey's com-

ments echoed earlier criticisms of "American hypocrisy" by another well-known American church leader. The Rev. Dr. Henry Pitney, president emeritus of New York's Union Theological Seminary, recently condemned "the flat contradiction between American governmental policy and the practices of American commerce and finance" in regard to South Africa.

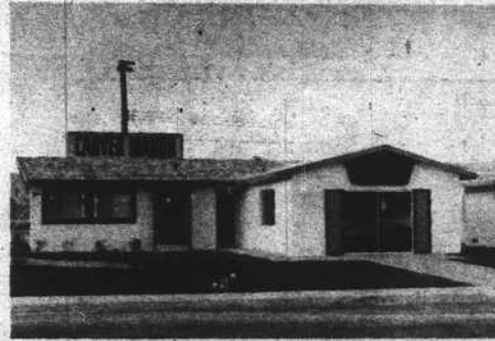
