MAKING THE MARKET ORDER

TO CARRY OUT the week's menus as planned, food must be supplied at home or purchased from the grocer. When food needs are known in advance, buying is easier and better use can be made of the budget allowance.

If you know a food will be served more than once a week, you can take advantage of



purchasing in larger quanities for less money. A large can of tomato juice is cheaper than the same amount from two or three smaller cans.

Planned menus also save trips to the market. Home storage of perishable and staple

foods can be better organized. The oven can be used more economically, and leftovers will be better used.

As the Homemaker, you are repaid for the trouble of keeping a simple market list and shopping periodically by the saving in time and money and by the convenience of being able to get a meal without a special trip to the market. One should lists staples for prompt replacement, and note special needs for the week's menus well in advance.

Buying in quantity where storage facilities permit and the food can be safely kept also helps to cut down the family budget. Careful planning well ahead of immediate needs allows one to take advantage of sales and other special opportunities.
