A MAJOR BREAK-THROUGH on the Alabama civil rights front took place this week when Archbishop Thomas J. Toolen ordered all Roman Catholic schools in that state and northwest Florida integrated in Sept.

In a pastoral letter read to congregations in churches throughout his diocese, Toolen said his decision came after "much prayer, consultation and advice. I know this will not meet with the approval of many of our people, but in justice and charity, this must be done. I ask all our people to accept this decision as best for God and country. No matter what personal feelings are, the common good for all must come first."

Approximately 25,000 students in some 80 elementary and 13 high schools are affected by the order. Up to now, only 11 Negroes have been admitted to white public schools in Alabama.

Smaller religious groups that meet in abandoned lofts and store fronts often are "closer to God" than worshippers using large and ornate churches according to a Methodist bishop.

"The very building we call a church may be a debit in the community if it stands as a fortress repelling the neighborhood because of its insular membership and icy aloofness," Bishop Lloyd C. Wicke of New York told the Methodist general board of evangelism in Oklahoma City. "On the other hand, the church may be an oasis, a city of refuge, if it represents the open door policy that 'All who are in need are welcome here'."

Adding financial injury to insult, so to speak, the United States Supreme Court has ordered a Montgomery, Ala., city commissioner to pay the entire court costs of

\$13,327 for his unsuccessful damage suit against four Negro ministers and the New York Times (Voice, March 19).

The high court had previously reversed an Alabama court award of \$500,000 to L. B. Sullivan, who claimed he was maligned by a Times advertisement signed by the four clergymen because of his actions as Montgomery police chief during a civil rights demonstration.

A Negro graduate of Amherst College who holds a master's degree from Harvard Graduate School of Education, has been named among Boston's top ten young men by the Greater Boston Junior Chamber of Commerce.
