Brown Cracks Down

SAN FRANCISCO--California's trade unions were put on notice here last week that the state intends to push hard to open more apprenticeship training programs to minority groups.

Non-discrimination rules have been adopted for admittance of young beginners to some trades, Governor Edmund G. Brown noted, and "the... task now is to make these procedures work."

Brown's remarks, in a speech to more than 1200 delegates at the California Conference on Apprenticeship, followed a less veiled comment by Charles Hanna, the chief of his apprenticeship standards division.

"For those groups who have built-in traditional discrimination," Hanna told a workshop discussion, "we can only say that we will continue to break down these evil practices."

"The time for them to voluntarily abandon

these practices has just about run out."

Hanna said, "Many of the trades, such as carpentry, bricklaying, plastering and others do not now have nor have they ever had racial barriers."

But overall, he added, indications are that progress is "far from satisfactory," with no more than 15 per cent of the State's 24,000 apprentices coming from minority groups.

The state, Hanna declared, will do all it can to help minority groups get training, "even if we all have to do much more than getting them an even-break."

Brown noted, however, that the problem goes beyond this, to a need for greatly expanded apprenticeship programs in general.

California, he noted, is ahead of other states, but nevertheless "only one-fourth of the California employers who could be training apprentices are doing so."
