New SA.Condemnation

UNITED NATIONS--South Africa's polic-ies in Southwest Africa were condemned last week by the special United Nationals Committee on Decolonization.

A 15-nation resolution warning South Africa that widespread bloodshed could result from the police state's apparent efforts to take Southwest Africa into the republic was approved by a 21-0 vote, with the United States, Great Britain and Australia abstaining.

The resolution said any attempt by South U. S. representative, Africa to annex a part said the United States or a whole of the territory would violate international law, the mandate under which South Africa has administered the onetime German territory

since League of Nations days, and the U. N. charter.

The resolution called for the Security Council to keep an eye on the situation as a serious threat to peace.

It also asked Secretary-General U Thant to keep trying to establish a U. N. presence in the territory in the form of a technical assistance representative who would pave the way for educational and other reforms aimed at giving the territory independence. Sidney R. Yates,

strongly opposed a-partheid (segregation) but could not support the resolution because it did not agree that the situation threatened international peace.
