Senate assignments and committee appointments of U. S. Senator Howard W. Cannon:

- Jan. 1959 -- Sworn in as a member of the United States Senate; Appointed to Committee on Armed Services; Committee on Rules and Administration.
- Feb. 1959 -- Appointed to special Space Subcommittee to investigate budget requirements of National Aeronautics and Space Administration.
- Mar. 1959 -- Appointed to Military Construction Subcommittee; Special Subcommittee to investigate waste and potential agency conflicts in development of U. S. Space Program.
- Apr. 1959 -- Appointed Co-Chairman of special Subcommittee on establishment of Veterans Affairs Committee.
- Feb. 1960 -- Appointed to Board of Visitors to U. S. Naval Academy.
- Jan. 1961 -- Appointed Chairman of Privileges and Elections Subcommittee; Subcommittee on Standing Rules of Senate.
- May 1961 -- Elected Chairman of Board of Visitors to U. S. Air Force Academy.
- Aug. 1961 -- Appointed to NATO Parliamentarians Conference.
- Nov. 1961 -- Elected Chairman of Military Committee of NATO Parliamentarians.
- Feb. 1962 -- Appointed to Special Subcommittee to investigate the national stockpile of strategic materials; Board of Visitors to U. S. Military Academy.
- Apr. 1962 -- Appointed Senate Advisor to United Nations Committee on Peaceful Uses of Outer Space.
- Feb. 1963 -- Appointed to Committee on Interstate and Foreign Commerce.
- Mar. 1963 -- Appointed to Commerce Subcommittee on Aviation; Commerce Subcommittee on Surface Transportation.
- June 1963 -- Appointed Chairman of special Subcommittee on Military Pay Bill; Co-Chairman of U. S. Senate Youth Program.

He has declared himself to be on the side of social and economic justice for the Negro. When elected, he can be counted upon to represent all the people of Nevada regardless of race or religion.
