

NEGRO ELECTED TO CITY COUNCIL IN RICHMOND, VA.

RICHMOND, Va.--A Negro has been elected to the Richmond City Council for the first time in 16 years and the voters gave him the second highest number of votes among 21 candidates.

Two other Negro candidates in Richmond, and Negro hopefuls in at least seven other cities and towns, lost their bids to get on governing boards as municipal elections were held throughout the State.

The Negro elected in Richmond was B.A. Cephas Jr., a member of the City Planning Commission and one of the six successful candidates fielded by a new political organization, Richmond Forward, for the city's nine Council seats. He polled 16,512 votes, second only to the 18,042 collected by Eleanor P. Sheppard, the current Mayor and another Richmond Forward candidate.

Oliver W. Hill, who served on Richmond's Council in 1948-50, is the only other Negro elected in the capital city of Virginia in this century.

Three Richmond incumbents were defeated in the election, which polled 30,931 votes, a record for a Council election. The other two Negro candidates, who had been backed by Voters

Voice, trailed near the end of the field.

Negro candidates also lost in Danville, where a slate expressing support of the city's handling of last year's racial troubles won election, and in Martinsville, Portsmouth, Norfolk, Hopewell, Culpeper and Lynchburg.

In Culpeper, Mortimer M. Marshall, a Negro funeral director, was disqualified when it was learned that he had been delinquent in paying his poll tax, officials said.
