

CANNON LASHES AT EXTREMISTS

CARSON CITY--Nevada Senator Howard W. Cannon last week filed his candidacy for a second term, pledging his determination "to conduct a vigorous campaign on the issues throughout every corner of the State."

The Senator, who arrived in the State on July 2 to begin a series of visits in western and southern Nevada, said he would review his record and present a program of continuing "sound growth and development of our natural and human resources."

Cannon said that Nevada and the nation is moving through a tense period in history and voiced confidence that "the voters of Nevada... will reject the extremists who have already begun their attempts to capture the 1964 election contests."

His statement on filing follows:

"In seeking a second term in the United States Senate, it is my intention to conduct a vigorous campaign on the issues throughout every corner of the State.

"The voters of Nevada, in my opinion, will reject the extremists who have already begun their attempt to capture the 1964 election contests.

"The needs of the State of Nevada have occupied my attention in Washington for six years, and I intend to review those years thoroughly before the electorate. But I am equally determined to lay before the people of this State a program of sound growth and development of our natural and human resources.

"We are living through a tense period in history when the national decisions which must be made in the United States Senate will form the shape of the nation and the world for years to come.

"In beginning my campaign, I am fully aware that as a Senator for Nevada I have a dual obligation--to the people of this State and to Americans of every state.

So long as I serve in the Senate, I will do my level best to uphold both of these trusts according to the dictates of my conscience and in the best interests of our State and nation."

ful public demonstrations, to urge repeal of such laws or to effect change of such customs.

"If and when the means of legal recourse have been exhausted or have been demonstrably inadequate, Christians may then choose to serve the cause of racial justice by disobeying a law that clearly involves the violation of their obligations as Christians."

The statement said that persons engaging in civil disobedience should direct their protest against a specific grievance or injustice; carry it out in a non-violent responsible manner and accept the penalty for their action.

The statement also prohibited racial discrimination within the church; called for initiation of programs supporting Christian fellowship; lobbying for enactment and enforcement of legislation guaranteeing equal rights in all areas to all persons without regard to race.
