

Educator Condemns School Testing Procedure

SAN FRANCISCO -- Dr. Morris Meister, president of Bronx Community College, urged American schools and colleges to abandon their "arsenal of testing instruments" for Negroes and other disadvantaged pupils. These tests, he said, are "emotionally loaded and place students in double jeopardy. Such boys and girls can't pass tests, can't get into college, can't get educated."

He spoke at the annual meeting of the Amer-

ican Council on Education, largest college organization in the country with 1,300 member institutions and organizations.

He declared that "tests are most reliable for the top third and the bottom third of our students, but they don't tell us much about the student in the middle--the late bloomer, the slow starter and the victim of educational malpractice, both in the home and the school. For these students, we must abandon such tests."

Dr. John U. Monro, Dean of Harvard College, agreed at the same session that "we know that much of our present testing fails to measure intellectual ability in slum children, and so in effect helps cut them off from college admission."

He called on American educators "to perform a truly Herculean task" in making increased educational opportunity available to the disadvantaged, but he conceded that to date "our progress has been discouragingly slow."

SCHOOLS AND COLLEGES, he continued, must break the "vicious circles of second-rate education in which poor youngsters, especially Negro youngsters in the South, go to weak schools."

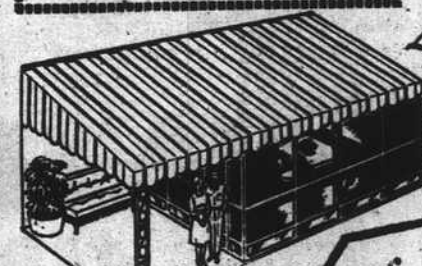
