Shaw, 42, was sworn in by Postmaster General John A. Gronouski who came here from Washington, D.C. for the occasion.

Showing no signs of nervousness, the tall, handsome post-master intoned the oath "I do solemnly swear" carefully and articulately as almost 1,000 fellow citizens looked on.
