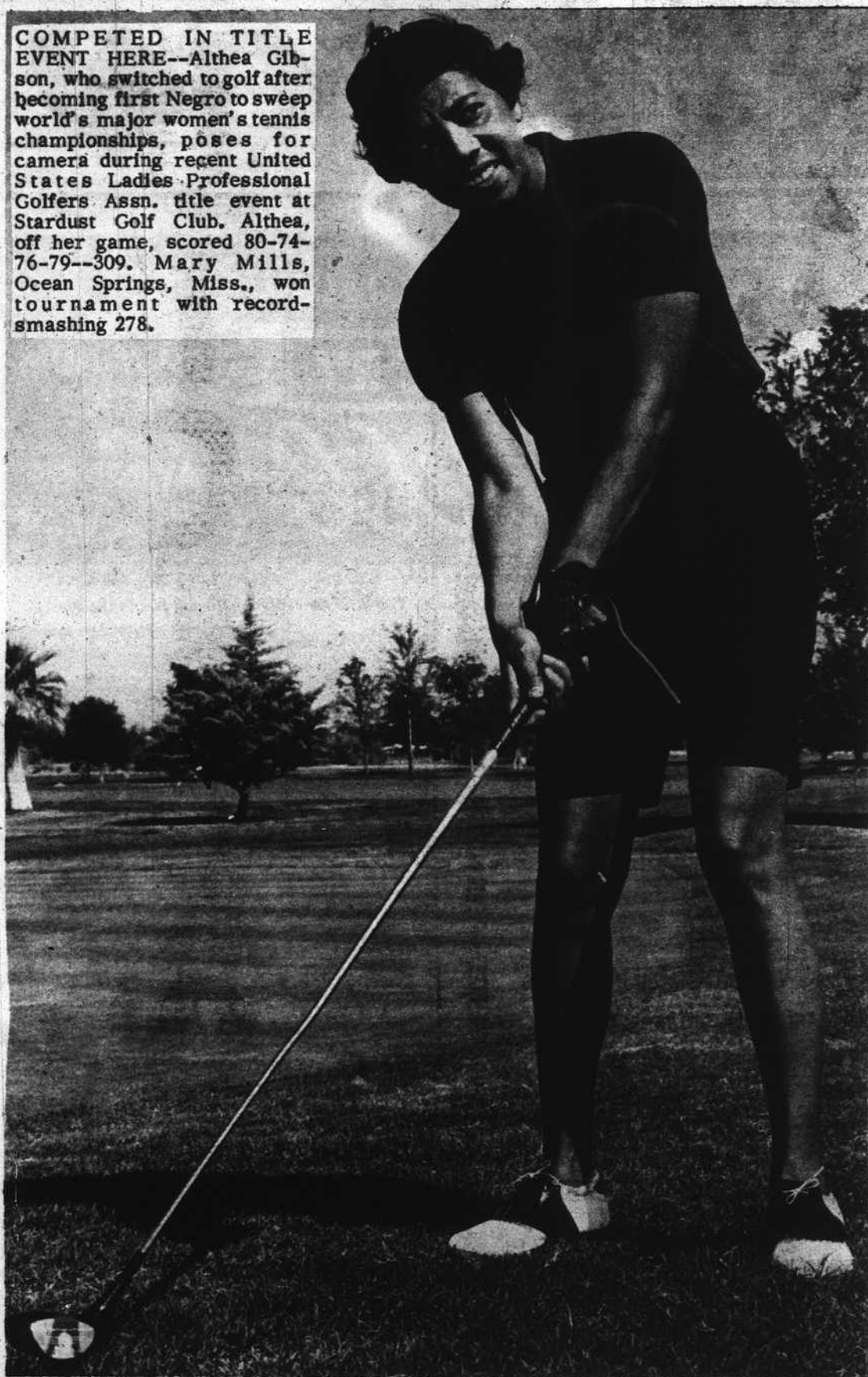

1. A person will be selected in each precinct two weeks prior to Election Day and designated as the "Get Out the Vote" Chairman. This person will be paid for part-time work, approximately \$25 per week. He will be supplied with a list of each registered voter in the precinct and required to submit to the central organization a report of his contact with each individual voter, including hours when the voter is normally home. On Election Day the precinct "Get Out the Vote" Chairman will be assigned with a voters list to cover the polls of his precinct.

2. Assigned to each precinct on Election Day at a salary between \$10 and \$15 will be two precinct walkers. These walkers will be armed with a voters registration list and should be required to cover the entire precinct twice. The first call will be devoted to getting out the maximum early vote and the locating of voter registrants' homes where voters are at work. The walkers will be armed with door-knob hangers to place on doors where no one is at home. The door-knob hanger should remind the absent occupant to vote and should have a telephone number where election services such as rides to the polls and baby sitting could be secured. The precinct walkers will be directly under the supervision of the precinct "Get Out the Vote" Chairman, will check with him periodically for the purpose of bringing their lists of those who have voted up to date.

3. There will be a supervisor assigned to each 4 or 5 precincts. This person preferably will be an officer or member of the Voters League and will by automobile check the performances of each precinct. There are 12 precincts and 2 separate areas, making a total of 46 persons involved directly in the "Get Out the Vote" campaign. In addition to this, there will be a number of automobiles assigned, one for each two precincts, during the heavy periods between 4 and 7 p.m. A sufficient number of telephones will be available so that during the peak period walkers and "Get Out the Vote" workers will not be hampered by an inability to reach automobiles.

The success of this type of program will depend upon its organization and the orientation of the "Get Out the Vote" workers prior to Election Day. Alternate workers will be selected to replace those assigned as walkers who for any reason are unable to participate.
