

WINDSOR PARK DEVELOPMENT LAUNCHED—One of Southern Nevada's most ambitious housing projects is now officially under way following groundbreaking ceremonies at Windsor Park in North Las Vegas. Development will consist of 476 moderately priced single family homes, 275-space mobile home park and sites for schools, churches and commercial complexes. Initial unit of 73 three and four bedroom, two-bath homes priced at 14,700 now under construction is already more than half sold according to the developer. Subsequent units are now in the planning stage according to a spokesman for Rohr Aircraft Corporation's architectural and home-building division.
