

DR. CARVER'S POETIC ADVICE TO YOUNGSTERS

DESPITE SUCH BRAVE WORDS, the danger of expropriation--a polite word for confiscation or nationalization--hangs over the Volta works, particularly the aluminum smelter, as shown by safeguards the United States has taken.

The foreign aid agency has written a "political risk guaranty" which insures 90% of the \$32 million the Kaiser Aluminum & Chemical Corp. and the Reynolds Metals Co. have contributed toward the cost of the smelter.

The guaranty also covers a \$22 million Kaiser-Reynolds contingency fund to be used if the smelter cost goes above estimates.

Also, the American loan arrangements entitle the United States to withdraw any time for financial, and in some cases, political reasons.

Further, the United States must withdraw from such a project if its aid no longer complies with the congressional mandate to help free and friendly governments remain independent.

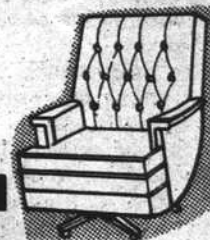
