

OFFER UNEMPLOYED DRAFTING COURSE

CARSON CITY--A 20-week training course in structural drafting, designed to prepare jobless Nevadans for employment with the State Highway Department and private engineering firms, is scheduled to open Feb. 15 in Carson City.

Bruce Barnum, executive director of the Nevada Employment Security Department, said the course will be financed by the federal Manpower Development and Training Act and supervised by his agency in cooperation with the Nevada Highway Department and the Ormsby County School District.

All Nevadans presently unemployed, regardless of their place of residence, are eligible to apply for the instruction. Those interested are advised to contact one of nine offices of the State Employment Service. Offices are located in Reno, Las Vegas, Carson City, Elko, Fallon, Ely, Winnemucca, Lovelock and Al Tahoe, Calif.

Heads of families who qualify may be eligible to receive up to \$50 each week as a training allowance. In addition, a trainee whose permanent residence is beyond daily commuting distance from Carson City may also qualify for a weekly \$35 subsistence allowance.

Those accepted for training will be taught applied mathematics, engineering drawing, descriptive geometry, trigonometry, structural drafting, topographical drawing, structural analysis, use of slide rule, technical reporting and strength of materials.

"Purpose of this course is to give trainees a solid background in the fundamentals of structural drafting," Barnum said. "Drafting is a highly-specialized occupation and one which provides opportunity for advancement into other specialized areas of the engineering field."

Instruction is scheduled to begin Feb. 15 at Carson City High School. Students will attend

classes from 4:30 p.m. to 10 p.m. on weekdays and for five hours on Saturday, a total of 35 hours each week.

John Hawkins, director of special services for the Ormsby County School District, will provide facilities and equipment for training, while the State Highway Department will furnish instructors.

More than 500 Nevadans have received instruction under the Manpower Development and Training Act since 1962.

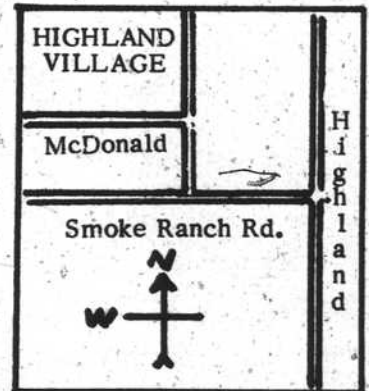
