Young Girls Cultivate Culture, Civic Responsibility at Doolittle

PERSONALITY DEVELOPMENT of pre-teen age girls through cultural projects and active participation in community programs is being promoted by the "Happy Times Club" of Doolittle Recreation Center with remarkable success.

Recognizing the need for appreciation of cultural and civic values among young girls, Mrs. Joe Haynes, wife of the Doolittle Center director, and Mrs. A.D.

Guy, whose husband is administrative assistant to the Clark County district attorney, decided to organize a young misses club in West Las Vegas.

It was expected that a dozen or so youngsters would answer the call when notices were sent to elementary schools in the area inviting girls between the ages of six and 12 to participate in the program. Much to the surprise of the organizers, however, some

100 girls between five and 13 turned out for the first meetings. More important, most of them are still actively taking part in the club's various projects without inducements other than the opportunity for self-improvement and contributing to the welfare of the community under their slogan, "Cultural for Service."

Among the club's first activities were a tour of "The Living Nativity" at Las Vegas Convention Center, a Christmas Party and a pre-New Year's Eve Party. The girls also took part in Negro History Week programs, including the presentation of interpretive dances at Kit Carson School. (See photo)
