An exhibition of science projects by students of various grades will be on view in the Multi-Purpose Room. Awards will be presented for the most interesting entries from each grade, with ribbons going to first, second and third place winners and certificates to other exhibitors.

The event, bringing together all senior high schools of the district, is receiving full cooperation from Nevada Southern University through its Humanities and Fine Arts Division chairman, Dr. Paul Harris.

Judges are Matt Kelly principal John Walker, PTA president Claude Parson, teachers John Morgan and Marvin Ellis and Mr. Wilkinson. The Cub Pack committee meets each Tuesday night at 7 o'clock in the Matt Kelly library.

Nevada Southern will host eight parts of the Festival, scheduled for 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. on both Friday and Saturday. Four contestants from each district high school will compete in oratory, pantomime, extemporaneous speaking, women's oral interpretation, men's oral interpretation, Women's dramatic reading, men's dramatic reading and informative speaking.

Friday night, the Las Vegas High School Auditorium will be the site of one-act plays which will be continued on Saturday. Performances Friday start at 7 p.m. Debate teams will complete the program at Rancho High on Saturday starting at 8 a.m.

Three California schools have been invited to participate for the first time. They are Needles, Burroughs and Pomona.
