

NARCOTICS EXPERT ing of a crippled youth by narcotics addicts in New York City, he moved to the racially-troubled Bedford-Stuyvesant area of Brooklyn and began a one-man campaign to combat the drug traffic and help young addicts at the "pavement level."

His fearless dedication and determined efforts in behalf of misguided youth soon attracted national attention and led to creation of a nondenominational, foundation-type organization called Teen Challenge, which is now supported by wealthy individuals and several corporations.

Teen Challenge centers have since been established in other large cities besides New

York, including Los Angeles, San Francisco, Chicago and Detroit. The Rev. Wilkerson's work has been featured in such widely-circulated magazines as Life, Good Housekeeping and McCall's and he has appeared on wellknown radio and TV shows like Art Linkletter's House Party.

The Rev. Wilkerson vividly described his early battles against teen-age crime in big city slums in 'The Cross and the Switchblade,' written in collaboration with John and Elizabeth Sherrill, who edit Dr. Norman Vincent Peale's publications, and published in 1962.




