

## Camera Reports on Sports of All Sorts

## Rodeo Tickets 75° Up

ADMISSION to the Helldorado rodeos at Cashman Field tonight through Sunday (May 13-16) will cost 75 cents for children and \$1.75 for adults (general), with tickets on sale at the gate or the Elks Club, 900 Las Vegas Blvd. North. Reserved seats at higher prices also are available.

In retaining the same price scale as in previous years, the Helldorado Committee admitted there had been some discussion about increasing the tariff this year due to increased production costs. But a spokesman for the committee said "the rodeos are for the public and it wouldn't be fair to some in the community, especially family people, if we raised the prices."
