

FINAL HEARING MAY 27 ON JULEART TRAILERS

FINAL PUBLIC HEARING on an application by the operators of Juleart Trailer Park for a variance to deviate from the city trailer ordinance has been scheduled for 7:30 p.m. next Thursday, May 27, at Las Vegas City Hall.

The 138-space trailer park, which extends north and east from the northeast corner of Owens Ave. and 'H' St., has been under fire from West Las Vegas civic groups for many years as a "menace to health and safety" and as an "eyesore."

Operators of the park have been cited for numerous violations of the trailer ordinance, but periodic "cleanups," termed "incomplete and ineffectual" by critics, plus official red-tape, have thwarted attempts by residents of the neighborhood to have the park condemned according to Frank Anderson, chairman of the Las Vegas NAACP Housing Committee.

inconceivable that resistance to the Court's findings still exists in some sections of the nation. But the wall of nonconformance is fast crumbling under the impact of the Civil Rights Act of 1964.

However, there is another aspect of this long-time problem that deserves closer attention. It concerns the necessity for a more reasonable degree of equality in regard to the amount of money spent for educating children in the public schools.

IT IS COMMON KNOWLEDGE today that children in segregated--or de facto segregated--communities are accorded only one-fourth to one-half of what other children receive in terms of per-pupil expenditure for educational purposes. It is not intended to imply that the education of school children must be measured in dollar comparisons. But it is obvious that an expenditure of \$250 per pupil, or even \$500,

will not purchase the same educational opportunity provided by an expenditure of \$1,000 per pupil.

It is clear that educational expenditures for children in less economically sound areas should be increased. Children located by the accident of birth in poverty-stricken areas should not be further penalized by the burden of inferior education through unequal distribution of the wealth.

What is being said here is that more money should be placed where it is needed most--in areas where segregation, be it intentional or de facto, in educational programs exist.

GALLIANO MIST

Fill old-fashioned glass with cracked ice. Pour 1 oz. Galliano over ice and squeeze and drop 1/4 section fresh lime into glass. Stir and serve.

ITALIAN STINGER COCKTAIL

1 oz. Galliano
1 1/4 oz. Brandy
Shake well with cracked ice. Strain into cocktail glass.

COCKTAIL ST. VINCENT

(Prize-Winning Recipe--Associazione Italiana Barman e Sostenitori)
1 oz. Galliano
1 oz. Light Cream
1 oz. Gin Few drops of Grenadine
Shake with ice and serve in cocktail glass.

GOLDEN CADILLAC

1 oz. Galliano
1 oz. White Creme de Cacao
1 oz. Cream
Place in blender with small quantity of crushed ice. Use low speed for short time until creamy. Pour into champagne glass.

WHITE MINK

1 oz. Galliano
1/2 oz. Triple Sec
1/2 oz. Vodka
1/2 oz. Cream
1/2 oz. Orange Juice
Shake with ice. Strain into champagne glass.

GOLDEN DREAM COCKTAIL

(Prize-Winning Recipe--United Kingdom Bartenders Guild)
1 oz. Galliano
1/2 oz. Cointreau
1/2 oz. Orange Juice
1/2 oz. Cream
Shake in cracked ice. Strain into cocktail glass.
