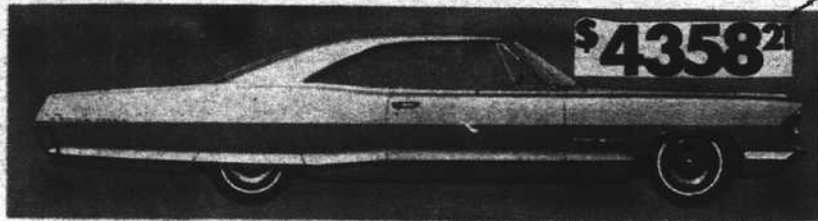

 Even though the 28 blocks comprising downtown take up less than one-half of one per cent of the city area, it accounts for nearly 45 per cent of all revenue the city collects for most business licenses and fees.

 Last year downtown businesses accounted for a total payroll of more than \$40 million. Las Vegas cannot afford to allow these businesses to deteriorate simply because potential customers can't park.
