Rev. Wesley Installed Sunday As Pastor of Needles Church

INSTALLATION SERVICES for the Rev. Jesse Wesley Sr. as pastor of St. James Baptist Church in Needles, Calif., will be conducted at 3 p.m. next Sunday, July 11, in the lower Colorado River community.

The Rev. Wesley has been serving as associate minister at the Bethel Baptist Church here and the Rev. I. W. Wilson, Bethel pastor, will deliver the installation sermon in Needles: on Sunday. Another member of the Bethel staff, the Rev. Roy Wilson, son of the pastor, will say a special prayer.

Other prominent West Las Vegas ministers who will participate in the installation ceremonies are the Rev. F. N. Addison, pastor, New Jerusalem Baptist Church, who will read the Scripture lesson; the Rev. V.C.L.Coleman, pastor, Second Baptist Church, who will deliver the Charge to the Church and to the Pastor, and the Rev. D. W. Smith, former pastor of Evergreen Baptist Church, who will introduce the Rev. Wesley.

Also taking part from Las Vegas are Eld. James Anderson, who will welcome the Rev. Wesley in behalf of his fellow ministers in Needles; Sis. Mozelle Buckles, soloist, and members of the Bethel Baptist choir. (Eld. Anderson is assistant to the Rev. Clay Johnson, pastor of the Mt. Calvary Church of God in Christ in Needles.)

Bro. Booker T. Edmon Jr. of Needles will serve as master of ceremonies and welcome the new pastor in behalf of his new congregation.

Swanson (Henderson Park Village); Laurel Bushman (Moapa Valley).

Theron Goynes is director of the parent program, assisted by Twyla Staub. Rut. Nelson serves as secretary in this department. Keith Roylance, director; Marjorie Frank and Werner Wilkinson comprise the social worker staff. Peg McMillan, registered nurse, is in charge of the health service.

Dr. Caliguri is particularly anxious for parents with children in the program to attend as many classroom sessions as possible and also to avail themselves of the services provided by Goynes and Mrs. Staub.

The project director expressed regret that the current pilot program for kindergarten preparation was unable to accommodate all the children in the area who attempted to enroll. He said school district officials hoped to enlarge similar programs planned for the future.

Approximately half a million children are enrolled in more than 13,500 "Project Head Start" centers across the country for this important segment of the "War on Poverty." Nearly 40,000 professionals are involved in the program, assisted by 42,000 paid neighborhood residents and several times that number of volunteers.
