8. THE FUTURE HOPE: Our older hymnals were filled with hymns about heaven. "There's a Land that is Fairer than Day." "Will there be Any Stars in my Crown?" The fact that, as the British soldiers used to sing, "There'll be Pie in the Sky By and By" doesn't offer much in the way of pages and accurate TODAY. in the way of peace and security TODAY. Happiness can be secured far more through SERV-ICE and WORK than by looking longingly into the future. In the same way there are those whose hope of peace and happiness rests on their hope that Christ will return in their lifetime. But there is no assurance that He will do so., In every generation since the time of Paul there have been those who confidently expected Christ to return while they lived. Every generation has had its anti-Christs, from the Caesars to the Kaiser, Hitler, and their present-day counterparts. But even if Christ WERE to come in our lifetime (as, of course, He might) would His coming give us inward peace TODAY? If Christ is to be welcomed by His saints when He returns, they must have that inner peace and security that is characteristic of the saint who is too busy working for Him to wonder when He will return!

All of these attempts to answer the problem
