It was reported that among those from Washoe County who will be interviewed in Reno on Aug. 14 are Eddie Scott, former president of the Reno-Sparks NAACP, and Tom West, recently resigned member of the state equal rights commission.

Prior to last Saturday's interviews, Bailey, Mrs. Whitacre and Rudiak set up the commission agenda for the next six months, with at least one meeting scheduled for each month. Rudiak was handed a special investigatory assignment in the area of equal employment opportunity involving union apprentice programs.
