confirmed reports that Gray Line West is bringing in newer, more modern buses to replace the present decrepit rolling stock.

The new management also intends to eliminate confusion as to where passengers may board buses by placing easily-read "bus-stop" signs at regular intervals along the various routes, Collins said. The new manager obviously was baffled as to why this elementary adjunct of almost all metropolitan bus systems had not been long since initiated here.

HE FURTHER REVEALED that all drivers will be expected to carry enough coin and smaller bills to change large bills presented by passengers. He pointed out, however, that changing large bills can become quite a problem and expressed the hope that the public would cooperate by obtaining the exact or approximate fare before boarding buses whenever possible. Collins explained that drivers are now being

provided with \$50 in change before starting work and can obtain additional change at the 4th and Fremont Sts. terminal when they run. low

"We feel that courtesy is indispensable to successful public service," Collins said, "and Gray Line West will insist that all employees observe this fundamental rule. But we do not anticipate any difficulty in this area. We are satisfied from reports received thus far that almost all employees of the local system measure up to our requirements in this important respect.

You can assure the citizens of West Las Vegas that Gray Line West will make every effort to give them the best public transportation possible," he concluded.
