

# ADULT & VOCATIONAL EDUCATION

ADULT EDUCATION courses being offered by the Clark County School District starting next month are listed below. Registration for each course will be conducted during the first class, at which time the stipulated fee is due and payable. No refunds will be made after the second class meeting and all students must purchase their own text books.

With the exception of Apprenticeship, Journeyman-upgrading and Manpower Development Training programs, courses are open to all adults. High school students may be admitted with written authorization from their parents and day school principal. Out-of-school applicants under the compulsory school age of 17 must present authorization by the juvenile court.

High school diplomas may be awarded to students who complete requirements set forth by the Nevada State Department of Education. Persons intending to complete high school should contact the Adult Education Office, 401 S. 9th St., Las Vegas, as soon as possible so that past

school records may be obtained and evaluated to determine remaining requirements. The office is open from 8 a.m. to 9 p.m., Monday through Thursday, and from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. on Friday. Telephone 384-7816, 7817, 7818.

STUDENTS SEEKING high school credit must so inform the instructor when registering. Adults who have received one or more high school credits prior to the 1963-64 school year will be required to earn a total of 16 credits in order to complete requirements for a diploma. All other adults will be required to earn 17 credits. Required credits include: 3 credits in English, 1 credit each in American History, American Government, Science and Mathematics.

Personal counseling in regard to high school completion and vocational courses is available to individuals by appointment.

Equivalency tests are administered twice monthly for a fee of \$5.

Most classes require a minimum of 15 paid

enrollees. Classes failing to enroll the required number of paid registrants at the first meeting are subject to cancellation or rescheduling at a later date.

TRADE APPRENTICESHIP courses are offered in cooperation with state and local joint apprenticeship committees. To enroll in apprenticeship classes, an applicant must be a bona fide indentured apprentice registered with the State Apprenticeship Council.

Special classes may be formed in many special-interest areas providing (1) a qualified instructor can be obtained, and (2) a minimum of 15 adults are ready and willing to enroll in the class.
