FRIED FISH TARTAR

- 2 lb. fish fillets
- cup corn meal 1
- 1 cup sifted flour
- 1 tsp. salt
- Dash pepper
- 1 cup buttermilk

1/2 cup butter or margarine, melted

Buttermilk Tartar Sauce

Cet fish into serving portions. Combine corn meal, flour, salt and pepper, mixing well. Dip fish into buttermilk then roll in corn meal mixture. Cook fillets in butter 7 to

10 min., turning only once, until golden brown on both sides. Serve hot with Buttermilk Tartar Sauce. Makes 6 servings.

Buttermilk Tartar Sauce

- 2 tbsp. flour 1/2 tsp. paprika 1/2 tsp. salt 1 cup buttermilk 1 cup dairy sour cream 1/4 cup chopped parsley 2 tbsp. chopped stuffed olives
- 1 tbsp. capers

Combine flour, paprika and salt. Stir in buttermilk, sour cream, parsley, olives and capers. Cook over low heat, stirring constantly until hot and thickened. Serve with fried fish. Makes about 2 cups.


