HERBED CREAM SAUCE TOPS HAM AND SHRIMP

Ham and shrimp in a delicately herbed cream sauce makes an enticing supper dish served over hot rice.

HAM AND SHRIMP
1/4 cup butter or margarine
1/4 cup chopped onion
1/4 cup chopped celery

1/4 cup flour
1/2 tsp. salt
1/8 tsp. pepper
1/2 tsp. oregano
2 cups milk
4-oz. can sliced mushrooms, drained
1 1/2 cups cooked diced ham
2 5-oz. cans shrimp, drained

Melt the butter and add onion and celery. Cook until vegetables are tender, but not browned. Combine flour, salt, pepper and oregano. Blend into onion mixture and add milk, stirring constantly. Cook and stir until sauce is smooth

and thick. Fold in mushrooms, ham and shrimp, blending well. Cook, stirring constantly until ham and shrimp are heated through. Serve with rice, if wished. Makes 6 servings.

Omelets go fancy with a simple applesauce filling for Sunday breakfast or brunch.

Heat applesauce and fold in crumbled cooked bacon. Spread the filling over one-half the omelet and fold other half over to cover.

DIPPED IN BUTTERMILK

Fish Stars in Corn Roll

Fish fillets dipped in buttermilk and rolled in corn meal make a crispy dish to serve with tartar sauce.

FRIED FISH TARTAR

2 lb. fish fillets
1 cup corn meal
1 cup sifted flour
1 tsp. salt
Dash pepper
1 cup buttermilk
1/2 cup butter or margarine, melted

Buttermilk Tartar Sauce

Cut fish into serving portions. Combine corn meal, flour, salt and pepper, mixing well. Dip fish into buttermilk then roll in corn meal mixture. Cook fillets in butter 7 to

10 min., turning only once, until golden brown on both sides. Serve hot with Buttermilk Tartar Sauce. Makes 6 servings.

Buttermilk Tartar Sauce

2 tbsp. flour
1/2 tsp. paprika
1/2 tsp. salt
1 cup buttermilk
1 cup dairy sour cream
1/4 cup chopped parsley
2 tbsp. chopped stuffed olives
1 tbsp. capers

Combine flour, paprika and salt. Stir in buttermilk, sour cream, parsley, olives and capers. Cook over low heat, stirring constantly until hot and thickened. Serve with fried fish. Makes about 2 cups.
