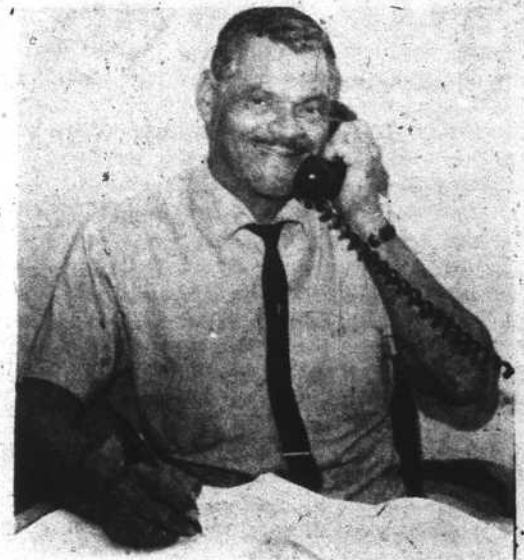

Woody Cole

WOODY COLE, long-time Constable of Las Vegas Township, is one of Nevada's most colorful personalities. The tall, gangling prototype of the Western "lawman" is the state's senior constable through tenure of office, having been first elected way back in 1946. He has been repeatedly returned to office by the electorate of sprawling Las Vegas Township by huge majorities.

Woody, who takes great pride in having been elected the first president of the Nevada Constables Assn., was an outstanding rodeo performer in his younger days and he served as a Deputy Sheriff in his native New Mexico and as a member of the Las Vegas Police Dept. and the Clark County Sheriff's Office before becoming the local constable.

In addition to being twice elected president of the Las Vegas Footprint Assn. without opposition, Woody has been active in the local Elks Lodge, Southern Nevada Amateur Athletic Union and the Las Vegas Press Club.
