



It was noted that the identity of a complainant does not need to be disclosed until a case is filed in court. However, ultimate responsibility for protection rests with local police authorities, rather than the federal government.

(8) The problem of employment discrimination encountered by Spanish-speaking groups in some areas was also mentioned. It was agreed that more study of this problem is needed,
