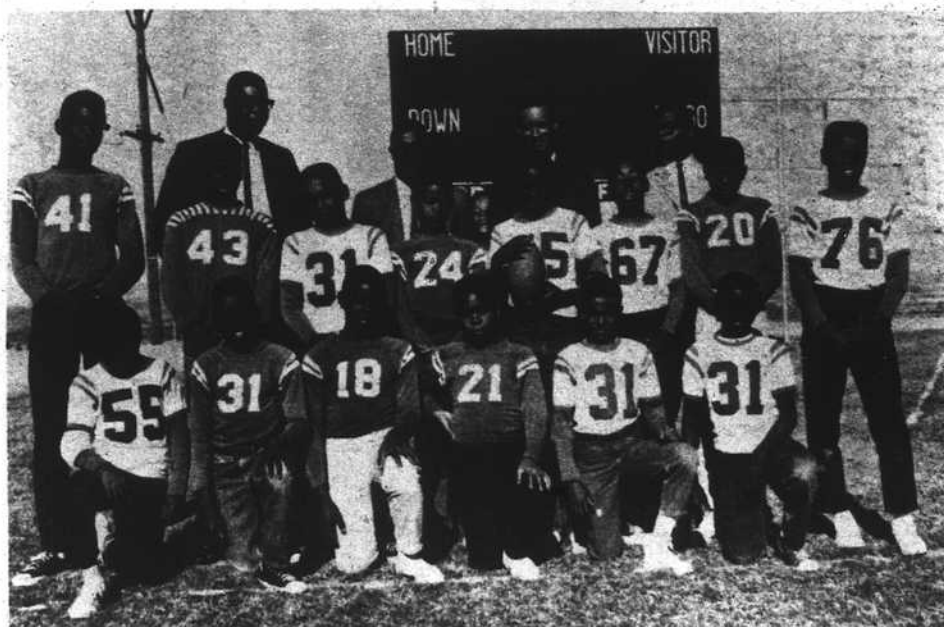


Locals In California Flag Football Tournament
