establishing a gas and oil cooperative in Bolivar, according to Nash Basom, Delta Ministry civil rights arms of the National Council of Churches.

Basom, who said the cooperative venture is only "a drop in the bucket in solving employment problems in the South...but it is a start," revealed that the gas cooperative will provide cut-rate gas and oil to Negro-owned filling stations.

ANOTHER VENTURE termed "good" in Selma is the Negro Business and Professional Men's new grocery store which opened this fall. Twenty Negro families contributed \$25 each last month to start a store in an abandoned building in Forkland, seven miles north of Demopolis, and ultimately hope to obtain a Small Business Administration loan.

In Greenville, Ala., a similar grocery cooperative is being organized by the Southern Christian Leadership Conference (SCLC); and a sewing cooperative is in the planning stage under the co-sponsorship of SCLC and the Georgia Council on Human Relations.

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
