Lions Club Program For The Blind Hailed

THE CARSON CITY LIONS CLUB made a notable contribution to the improvement of Services to the Blind throughout the State of Nevada. At a meeting of the Board of Directors held in Carson City, on February 15, 1966, the Board created a revolving fund to be used to make advancements to individuals receiving rehabilitation services from Nevada's Services to the Blind Division to enable them to pay necessary costs of transportation and other similar expenses incurred as an essential part of their rehabilitation program.

Such advance payments cannot be made under existing Nevada laws. Present law requires the submission of a claim against the State which is then processed and subsequently paid. To many individuals, funds are not readily available for such purposes and waiting for repayment often creates hardship.

Mervin J. Flander, Supervisor of the Services to the Blind Division, commented, "The Carson City Lions, are to be commended for their recognition of an area of needed services and for making a substantial contribution toward the eventual elimination of the need area. This is another noteworthy project consistent with the dedication of Lions Clubs and Lion International to Services to the Blind and Visually Impaired. The Division and the blind of Nevada deeply appreciate this contribution.'
