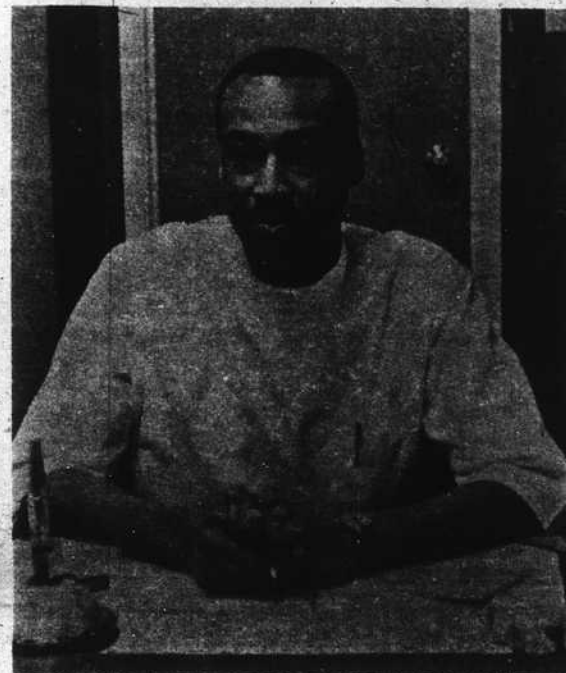

WELCOME DR. JOHN CREAR



Dr. Charles West, M.D. announced this week that Dr. John Richard Crear is now associated with him in his Medical Offices in the Golden West Shopping Center, 958 West Owens Ave.

DR. JOHN CREAR was born in Bryan, Texas and grew up in Houston, Texas where he attended the Charles Atherton Elementary School and Phyllis Wheatley High School. He received his Bachelor of Science Degree from Prairie View College, Prairie View, Texas.

After an Honorable Discharge from the Army Medical Corps with which he served in the South Pacific on the islands of Saipan and Guam, Dr. Crear entered Meharry Medical College's School of Clinical Laboratory Technology and earned a degree in Laboratory Technology.

Returning to Houston, the doctor worked for four years at the St. Elizabeth Hospital and four and one half years in the Clinical Laboratory and Medical Research Department of the Houston Veterans Administration Hospital. He was the first registered licensed Negro Laboratory Technologist to work at the Houston VA Hospital.

Dr. Crear attended Graduate School at the University of Texas in Austin for one year before entering Medical School at the California College of Medicine in Los Angeles, Calif., from which he received his M.D. Degree. He interned for one year at the Los Angeles County General Hospital and since serving his internship, Dr. Crear has been associated with the Bon Air Hospital in Los Angeles.

Dr. Crear is married to the former Barbara Wilson, also a native of Houston, Texas and they are the parents of twins--age 13--a son, John, Jr., and a daughter, Joan. Mrs. Crear is a graduate of Prairie View College receiving her B.S. Degree with a major in Dietetics and a minor in Science. She is a teacher in the Los Angeles City School system.
