Clark County Heart Drive May Reach Goal

RETURNS FROM the 1966 Heart Fund Campaign in Clark County totaled \$33,477.39, as compared with \$35,875.17 in 1965, it was announced today by Darwin Lamb, local Heart Fund Campaign Chairman. He expressed the hope that subsequent contributions would bring the campaign's yield to the neighborhood of \$36,000.

The residential Heart Sunday canvass, conducted from February 16 to 20, and headed by Mrs. Harris P. Sharp as Heart Sunday Chairman, so far has yielded \$9,708.26 with mail returns still coming in from families who were not at home when their Heart Sunday volunteers called.

"The response from people of Clark County to the 1966 Heart Fund appeal is dramatic evidence that they understand the seriousness of the heart problem," Mr. Lamb said. "It also demonstrates their conviction that the Nevada Heart Association's program of research, education and community service constitutes the most effective way to combat and, eventually, to control this leading health menace."

In addition to applauding the public's support of the drive, Mr. Lamb extended the Nevada Heart Association's thanks to the local newspapers and broadcasting stations for their cooperation, and to the laymen, physicians and related professionals who volunteered their time and effort to help conduct the drive.
