back the way he had come or be annihilated.

'He said to his men, 'These Africans are but the resemblances, nay, rather, the shadows of men, being worn-out with hunger, cold, dirt, and filth, and bruised and enfeebled among stones and rocks. Their joints are frost-bitten; their sinews stiffened with the snow; their limbs withered by the frost; their armour battered and shivered; their horses, lame and powerless. With such cavalry, with such infantry you will have to fight; indeed you will not have enemies in reality, but rather their last remains.

Moreover, we have beaten these miserable Carthaginians by land and sea often before. Now they have had the temerity to cross the Alps. But they won't be strong enough to return over it. We have them in a trap. What I do fear is that victory is going to be so cheap that the world is not going to give us credit for it.

"And Hannibal was in a really desperate position. Courage and initiative were his sole hopes. Assembling his men, he told them that he had promised to lead them to plunder such as no army had ever seen before and that it was now up to them to seize it or die in the attempt.

"To impress them with the critical nature of their position, he dramatized in the following manner: He had the enemy prisoners taken in the Alps brought before his men and throwing down before the captives the weapons with which they usually fought, he said to them. 'Each of you who is willing to fight a duel to the death with one of his own tribe let it be known. The winners will be set free and given horses, arms and money to take them to their homes again

"Every captive volunteered. Friend turned against friend until he slew him or was slain. Hannibal, true to his word, rewarded the victors.

"To his men, he said, 'You are like these captives, shut in on every side. Behind you are the Alps; before you, the Romans and the river. Your only hope is battle and victory.
'And victory will not be difficult. Think of the

splendid and prosperous career before you. It will conduct you to Rome, second in wealth only to Carthage. There are great treasures to be divided amongst us, if we win. If we lose we are lost, for there is no place of safety we can reach by flight. We must win."

Next week, the last in a series on Hannibal will tell of the incredible victory, over the Romans, and of the great warriors' subsequent (and equally incredible) military feats.
