

POVERTY PROGRAM WASHOE C.C.A.A.

As reported by Joe DeMao THE SUN VALLEY Improvement Organization was formed and incorporated in December of 1965. There are 23 members in the organization and nine board members. A five year lease has been obtained from the Land Owners Association for the Community Hall to be used for a Day Care and Child Development Center. Three bids for the renovation of the hall have been received and 23 members have volunteered their services to improve the facilities. A pro-

gram has been developed to conduct a Day Care and Child Development Center, and the applica-tion is now in the process of being completed for submission to this board via the Project **Evaluation** Committee.

Joe Williams, representing William Webb, Chairman of "Operation Contact" reported that their organization is working on by-laws and a constitution and will become incorporated in the near future. A tentative location has been donated by Joe Williams in which to conduct an Infor-

mation and Coordination Services Center. This

would give needed service to the poor in aiding them to obtain required assistance. A application is now in the process of being prepared for submission to this board.

- Rev. N. L. Logan, representing Rev. Solomon Harris, Chairman of the Black Springs Progress Club, reported they are trying to secure prop-erty either by purchase or lease for a Child Care Center. He also stated that local streets have been graded and that a petition has been circulated to improve the streets and sewers in the Black Springs area.
