Alan Pifer, acting president of Carnegie Corporation of New York, announced a \$180,000 Corporation grant to support the program during a speech at Jackson State College, Jackson,

The educational foundation also announced

six other grants totaling \$1,197,150.
FACULTY AND administration from a group of predominantly Negro colleges will be asked to nominate students in their junior year who have the ability to do the rigorous, scholarly, creative work demanded by the leading graduate and professional schools.

As part of the selection process these students will be interviewed by representatives of the graduate schools of Harvard, Yale, and Columbia, and the law schools of Columbia and

The three universities will provide full fellowships to all students coming through summer program who are admitted to the graduate and professional schools at Harvard, Yale, and Columbia.

THE PROGRAM STAFF will also assist students in filing applications and gaining admission to other graduate and professional schools.

The grant will cover all the student's expenses including travel, and will also provide a stipend in lieu of summer earnings to be applied against the student's tuition for his senior year.

The program will consist of specially designed seminars, and courses in the social sciences and English selected from the university's regular summer session.

These courses will be given by outstanding faculty members from all three universities. Extensive reading and writing will be integral to the program with weekly papers and at least one major project.

Graduate and professional school students will serve as academic tutors and will live in
