

1966 NEVADA FISHING SEASONS AND REGULATIONS

"Game fish" defined. As used in this title, "game fish" means and includes steelhead and all other trout, charr, whitefish, salmon or landlocked salmon, and all varieties of bass, perch, sunfish, crappie, and catfish. All other fish shall be deemed "coarse fish."

"Cold water fish." All species of trout, salmon, charr, and whitefish.

"Warm water fish." All species of game fish not listed in the above classification of "cold water fish."

"Fishing" defined. As used in this title, the words "to fish" and their derivatives, "fishing" and "fished," mean and include catching, capturing, killing, injuring, gaffing dip netting, and crippling of fish, and the pursuing, baiting, and decoying of game fish with intent to catch, capture, kill, injure, gaff, dip net, or cripple the same, and every attempt to catch, capture, kill, injure, gaff, dip net, cripple, pursue, bait, or decoy any game fish

SPECIAL REGULATIONS

LAKES MEAD AND MOHAVE AND COLORADO RIVER

(Clark County)

Acenses: The State of Nevada shall provide a "Special Use Stamp" valid for the period January 1 to December 31, at a fee of \$2, for sale to persons holding valid fishing licenses issued by the State of Arizona. The State of Arizona shall provide a similar Special Use Stamp, for sale to persons holding valid fishing licenses issued by the State of Nevada. Such stamp shall be valid for the period July 1 to June 30 next, at a fee of \$2. One such combination of a fishing license from either state and a Special tion of a fishing license from either state and a Special Use Stamp from the other state shall be required of all persons 14 years of age or over who fish from any boat or other floating device on the waters above. The combior other hoating device on the waters above. The combination may also be used to fish from the shores, islands, or rocks of either state; however, persons having a valid fishing license from only one of the states may fish from the shores of that state only and shall not be required to possess a Special Use Stamp from the opposite state. No license or stamp is required of persons under 12.

Seasons: It shall be lawful to fish in the waters of Lakes Mead and Mohave and the Colorado River at any hour throughout the year except for closed areas immediately above and below Hoover and Davis Dams and the closed area at Callville Bay on Lake Mead (see closed

Closed Waters: The posted areas on Lakes Mead and Mohave and the Colorado River immediately above and below Hoover Dam and Davis Dam.

The Callville Bay area of Lake Mead, as posted, is closed to fishing March 1 through June 30.

Limits: The daily creel and possession limits on the above waters shall be 10 trout, 10 Kokanee salmon singly, or in aggregate with trout, 10 black bass, and 25 catfish, regardless of size and weight, 3 striped bass minimum size of 16 inches (total length). There shall be no limit on crappie or bluegill or other fish. All fish possessed or transported must be kept with head or tail attached, or in such manner that species and number may be determined. Persons under the age of 12 who are not residents of the State of Neyada and who are fishing without a license may take not more than one-half the legal limit of trout.

Tackle: It shall be lawful to take fish only by hook and line attached to rod or reel held in the hand or closely attended. Not more than two bait or fly hooks, nor more than two artificial lures (Dave Davies and flat-fish), (in one piece or jointed which may have more than one hook), may be used on one line and only one such line may be used at one time. Nongame fish may also be taken by licensed fishermen by spear and bow and arrow, except within one-half mile of any dock or swimming area. Artificial lights may be used provided they are not SPORTS

Live Boxes and Stringers: All unattended live boxes and stringers containing fish shall have a water resistant identification legibly bearing the name, address, and fishing license number of the person using and storing fish in such live box, or fish stringer. Where several persons utilize the same live box or fish stringer, each person shall personally attach his own identification to such live box or fish stringer.
