Adult Education Favored

WASHINGTON -- Legislation to encourage adults to complete the grade or high education they never had a chance to finish was co-sponsored recently by Sen. Howard W. Cannon of Nevada.

CANNON SAID he had polled a cross-section of Nevada educators and found strong support for the Adult Education Act of 1966 which would encourage citizens over age 18 to take advantage of a second chance at a minimal education.

The Nevada senator, who joined Sen. Vance Harke of Indiana in support of the measure, pointed out that there are 23 million adults over 25 who did not finish eight years of schooling and 55 million who did not complete high school. The program, he said, could be administered locally.

Cannon said Nevada had made some progress

in affording its citizens a "second chance for education" and could accomplish much more under the bill. The legislation contemplates a three-year program of federal grants to states which set up approved systems of adult education.

It would allow use of the funds for leasing necessary space for classes, including public halls, churches and other facilities which are normally idle much of the time. Public schools could be used for evening classes.

Cannon said passage of the bill could improve the employment opportunities of adults of all ages and "certainly would contribute to the enrichment of their lives, regardless of age."
