brought in canine dogs in an attempt to clear the streets. One dog bit Juan Gonzales when he cursed and spat at a policeman. All taverns in the area were closed by police until further notice.

Mayor Richard J. Daley held a three-hour meeting with Puerto Rican leaders during which he appealed for peace. Those meeting with him pledged they would do all they could to keep crowds off the streets.

Supt. Wilson later issued a general order intended to speed integration of two-man patrol cars and squadrols. He sent a young college-trained captain to command the West Side area. Lt. William B. Griffin, a Negro who formerly headed the city's burglary section of the police department, was shifted to district commander of the Grand Crossing district.

Wilson pointed out he had long urged white policemen to work voluntarily with Negroes in the department. The new order directs district and police task force commanders to integrate all two-man crews so far as minority group characteristics of their manpower will permit.

THIS MEANS that Negro, Latin American, Jewish or other minority group officers will not work together as two-man teams while there are two-man teams of other officers available for integration, according to Wilson.

The appointment of Lt. Griffin as a district commander brings to four the number of high ranking Negroes in the department. They are: Cmdr. Robert Harness, Wabash district; Cmdr. George Simms, Filmore; Cmdr. Harold L. Miles, Englewood, and Lt. Cmdr. Griffin, Grand Crossing.

The district commanders each have approximately 150 to 200 Negro and white policemen under them ranging, in ranks from captain to patrolmen.
