tions to schools with largest number of Negro students, and (2) to assure the employment AND assignment of Negroes in teaching and administrative positions throughout the school system.

7. That the Board of Education use, THROUGHOUT THE SCHOOL SYSTEM, new curricula materials, primary readers, and elementary-secondary texts and books which reflect a multi-racial country in their text and illustrations.

"THE LAS VEGAS Branch recognizes that it is the function of the School Board and the Superintendent of Schools to establish a policy which will provide equal educational opportunities for all the students of Clark County. It recognizes, also, that the problem is not an easy one, but it is of the opinion that something concrete must be done to bring this about and that mere recognition of the problem will not, by itself, provide a solution. The Branch is willing to work with the Clark County School Board and the Superintendent of Schools to bring about the establishment and implementation of such a policy. It is unwilling to let the situation just drift."
