POWELL PROTESTS TRAINING FUNDING TO URBAN LEAGUE

NEW YORK--(NPI) -- Rep. Adam Clayton Powell (D.-N.Y.) has attacked the allocation of federal manpower training funds to the National Urban League, which, he said, "In no way represents, nor speaks for, nor is in intimate contact with the black masses."

Rep. Powell said that Manpower Development contracts which the Department of Labor has signed with the National Urban League are "a prime example of foolish spending." He ridiculed the notion that "department's one-way ticket to the happy hunting ground of racial integration depended on these contracts."

The Urban League, the congressman said, "Has received hundreds of thousands of dollars

of MDTA funds to help train a few new black workers. Thus, while the National Urban League has been fattening its operational budget at the unknowing expense of the federal government, we have been witnessing more racial turbulence, more riots, more rebellions, more black resentment, and more disenchantment by the black masses of federal programs.

"I would strongly advise the Department of Labor to re-assess its relationship with the Urban League and the declining value of the League's role in black communities."

If the department fails to do that, Powell threatened to have his committee "re-assess MDTA's right to make such contracts."
